PAYMENT POLICY

Room to Ride Equestrian Center, Inc. (R2R) accepts cash and checks **ONLY**. Remittance is required at the time of service, and is welcome at any time prior to service. Any student with a negative account balance may be denied service and/ or scheduling of service.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Effective January 1, 2009, Room To Ride requires notification of all riding lesson scheduling changes **in advance** of the scheduled lesson.

- Scheduling changes and cancellations made at least 24 hours in advance will be accommodated at no charge.
- Scheduling changes and cancellations made less than 24 hours but more than 6 hours in advance will be arranged for \$20.
- Notice received less than 6 hours in advance will be charged \$40.

Students will forfeit the right to scheduling should they not call and not show to their lesson. To be scheduled for another lesson after doing a "no call/ no show," the student will have to come to R2R and pay for the missed lesson.
